The Fahrenheit Gallery presents the work of Max Key. In his second solo exhibition at the Fahrenheit Gallery Key will lend a series of intimately sized paintings that vicariously represent both seductive and cataclysmic affairs.

In 2006, Robin Trafton of the *Kansas City Star* stated that Key's paintings maintain a "characteristic subversion of traditional ornamentation through anxiety-provoking details that add an element of social commentary." This new body of work is further inspired by the sublimity of springtime fecundity and subversive news dissuasions. Key reworks the color of truth by creating an exploitative cast of fruitfully persuasive iconology.

The opening reception will be held on Saturday, May 5th, from 8–10 PM. The closing reception will be on Saturday, June 16th, from 12–4 PM. Outside of these reception dates the Fahrenheit Gallery is open on Saturdays from 12–7 PM and available by appointment.
